Goal:

The Missouri Valley Insulator Club shall be a non-profit educational and scientific organization to encourage insulator collecting and dealing, and the promotion of the The National Insulator Association.

Involvement:

All persons who are in any way interested in insulators shall be eligible to become a member. (There are currently 58 member/families--2010) Membership dues shall be set at \$5.00 per year for a single or family membership.

Activities:
